Rev. Dr. Sharon Watkins currently serves through the National Council of Churches (US) as director of its truth and racial justice initiative. She served as General Minister and President of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in the United States and Canada. She is a member of the Central Committee of the World Council of Churches and past chair of the board of the NCC. Dr. Watkins holds a Doctor of Ministry degree from Phillips Theological Seminary in Tulsa, Oklahoma, a Master of Divinity from Yale Divinity School, and a Bachelor's Degree in French and Economics from Butler University in Indianapolis, Indiana. She is married to the Rev. Dr. Richard H. (Rick) Lowery. They are the parents of two adult children.

Watkins is the author of *Whole: A Call for Unity in Our Fragmented World*.
